

VOLUNTEER TIPS

Here are a few points of advice to help you best serve Dupont Circle Village as a volunteer and to ensure that you best enjoy your experience.

- Have a good motive for (a personal interest in) the volunteer assignments you accept.
- **Be impartial and honest about your** skills and how they best suit DCV member and organization volunteer requests.
- Respect boundaries; do not assume responsibilities either as an advocate or advisor – beyond the scope of the assigned volunteer request.
- Respect the confidentiality of the member as related to the volunteer request.
- Obviously, be mindful of your own schedule and do not overcommit.
- Indeed, it is okay to say "No" to a request.
- Express interest in training and be willing to expand the range of your volunteering.
- Be open to new possibilities, like virtual volunteering do you have skills that are deliverable by computer or phone?
- Remember to use DCV Reporting Forms to keep track of and submit time of volunteer assignments.
